You may hand an order with payment attached (check or exact change in cash) to the office staff during business hours, 8 am- 5 pm., Mon.-Fri. If you want a written receipt, Angel Food order takers will be on duty at St. Paul's Welcome Center during the times shown below.

Policy on distribution. Our normal distribution period begins at 9:30 a.m. on a Saturday. If weather, mechanical, or unforeseen problems force a delay, then we will not begin later than 3 p.m. Saturday. If we are unable to begin by 3 p.m. Saturday, then distribution will be rescheduled for 3 p.m. of the next day, Sunday. If we are unable to begin on Sunday, then distribution will be delayed for one week until the following Saturday. If that fails, the next course of action will be posted at St. Paul's and announced on the Angel Food hotline, (479) 305-0215. Angel Food must be picked up during the actual distribution period, whether normal or rescheduled, and **this is a condition of sale.** St. Paul's is not responsible for the loss of food not claimed during an actual distribution.

Where is St. Paul's?

ENTER OUR PARKING LOT from College Ave., 200 feet south of Dickson Street, and across the street from the Court House. You can also enter our lot from Dickson Street, 200 feet west of College Ave., and across the street from the First Baptist Church.

Angel Food is distributed in our Welcome Center, located at the west end of our parking lot. Don't enter through the double doors — that's where you will come out with your food. Proceed along the side of the building to the single door, which leads to the check-in table.
