

Milestone Home Liturgy

Sentences in bold may be said inviting everyone to 'repeat after me'. One person can lead, or the leading can be shared.

Begin by saying

Hallowed be your name on earth as in heaven.

There is nothing in death or life, in the world as it is or the world as it shall be, nothing in all creation which can separate us from the love of God which is in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Love never comes to an end.

One person may read aloud the following Gospel reflection

God our life, you are the God of life.

You are the only God and we love you with all our heart.

We love our neighbor as ourselves.

God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, God of Sarah, Rebecca and Rachel, in helping the least important, we help you in your need and enter into your joy.

We love you with our whole heart and we love our neighbors as ourselves.

Milestone Prayers

You may invite each person to pick a stone and

- tell about what the stone reminds them of a joy or sorrow
- choose a stone that reminds them of what tomorrow will be like
- choose a stone that reminds them of someone else

Say together the Lord's Prayer

Finish by praying

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Let us pray.

Holy One, holy and always
exciting and amazing in your holiness;
make us merciful to receive your kindness
and to share your love with all the earth;
then will your name be hallowed on earth as in heaven.
